HAWAII FCE LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT FUND – to provide funds to individual members of Hawaii FCE for leadership development.

Purpose: 1. Funds to support and encourage Hawaii FCE members who choose to run for National FCE or ACWW positions.

- 2. Funds to assist members who are asked to represent Hawaii FCE at other conferences.
- 3. Funds to cover any related expenses for participation in workshops, conferences (excluding Hawaii FCE Annual Convention), or training sessions that develops character, knowledge, or methods of implementations in subject matter or topics that strive to strengthen or improve families and communities.

SPECIAL EDUCATION FUND – to provide funds to develop an individual, club, council, or state program/project in the area of Education, Leadership, or Community Action.

Purpose: Funds are to provide resources to Hawaii FCE members, clubs, councils, or state organization for the development of a project/program on a topic related to Education, Leadership development, or Community action (possibly including printed materials, advertisements, location fees, honorariums).

1st TIMER TO STATE CONVENTION SCHOLARSHIP - to help any Hawaii FCE member attending a State FCE Convention for the first time. The convention scholarship recipient will attend the opening ceremony, all business meetings, and educational workshops provided throughout the convention. Scholarship recipients are asked to submit a written report about the events of the convention they attended.

1st TIMER TO NATIONAL CONVENTION SCHOLARSHIP - to help any Hawaii FCE member attending National FCE Convention for the first time. The convention scholarship recipient will attend the opening ceremony, all business meetings, and educational workshops provided throughout the convention. Scholarship recipients are asked to submit a written report about the events of the convention they attended.

FCL/LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP - to help any Hawaii FCE member attend FCL or other leadership training workshops or seminars. Hawaii FCE believes that attending conventions and leadership training workshops helps build support, enthusiasm, a better understanding of our organization, effective skills, and techniques in leadership development. The scholarship recipient will abide by the agreement stated on the application. Scholarship recipients are asked to submit a written report on the workshop/seminar they attended.

CRITERIA:

- 1. Applicant must be an active Hawaii FCE member in good standing.
- 2. Applications must be received by the Hawaii FCE President 4-6 weeks prior to the event/activity application deadline. (example: if the application deadline for the workshop is June 15th, your scholarship application must be received by the Hawaii FCE President before May 15th.)
- 3. Must have a letter of recommendation by your Extension Educator or Council President or club president.
- 4. Recipients must share the knowledge gained, in whole or in part, with members of Hawaii FCE (either written or orally).

SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION PROCEDURES:

- 1. The Hawaii FCE Executive Committee shall review and select the scholarship winner 2-3 weeks before the event or activity deadline date. A member from this Board will notify all applicants on it's selection.
- 2. The Scholarship Application is a two-page form and defines the purpose of procedure.
- 3. Only first time attendees will be considered for State or National Convention.
- 4. FCL or leadership workshop attendees may apply as many times as desired.
- 5. If, for whatever reason, the recipient cannot attend the event, the funds will be returned to Hawaii FCE, immediately.
