PICTURE GUIDELINES –

- Use unlined, **white** paper approximately 8.5”x11” .
- Use a #2 pencil.
- Do not fold or color the picture
- Write your name, date, teacher’s name& school on the back of the picture.

ESSAY GUIDELINES –

- Use lined, white paper approximately 8.5”x11” .
- Essay should be at least 50 words long and explain the drawing.
- Use a #2 lead pencil.
- Write your name, date, teacher’s name& school at the bottom of the essay.

CONTEST GUIDELINES

All 4th grade students are eligible to enter.

Entries are to include a short story and a hand-drawn picture which reflect the characteristic of CITIZENSHIP.
