

Winter Hat Ornament

Supplies Needed:

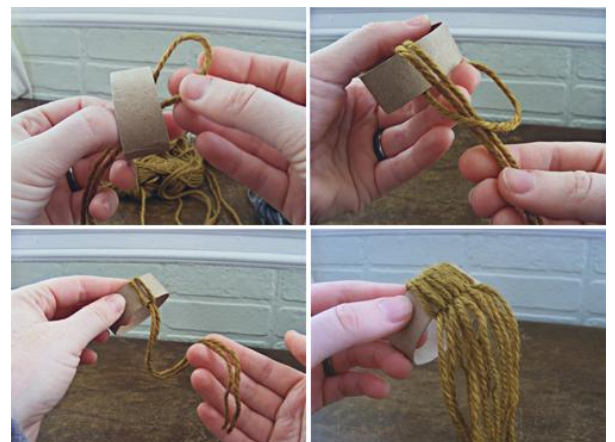
1. Scissors
2. Tube (toilet paper or paper towel)
3. Ruler or measuring tape
4. Scraps of Yarn (grab any size and any colors you have in your stash)
5. Pencil or sharpie

Instructions:

1. Flatten the paper tube (don't worry about bending it).
2. Measure sections that are 3/4 of an inch wide. Use your pencil or sharpie to mark and then cut. With a regular toilet paper tube I got five rings.
3. Cut yarn strands roughly 16 inches long. Don't worry about being too exact! Fold each piece in half and cut about 25 to 30 for each ornament.



4. Slip the loop from one strand of yarn through the paper tube. Loop it around the two ends and pull tight. Make sure you have enough strands to cover the paper tube, but don't squash the yarn too closely together.
5. Now squish all these strands through the tube.....you just formed the brim of the hat!
6. Using one of your strands of yarn, tie a double knot about an inch from the brim.
7. Also use one of the strands to tie a little loop to use to hand the ornament.
8. Trim the loose strands to form a puffball. Make it as fluffy or short as you want.
